Call for papers:

Call for peer reviewers and advisory board members:

The *Journal of Organics* invites your nomination as a peer reviewer and/or an advisory board member if you are qualified in topics of interest to the *Journal of Organics*.

Call for book reviews and book reviewers:

The *Journal of Organics* invites the submission of book reviews that are relevant to topics of interest to the *Journal of Organics*. Book publishers are invited to submit copies of relevant books proposed for review to the Editor-in-chief.

Call for guest editors of Special Issues:

The *Journal of Organics* welcomes proposals for Special Issues. A Special Issue will generally include at least three papers related to a particular topic. A proposal to be a guest editor should include the topic of the proposed Special Issue, a statement of the qualifications and experience of the proposed guest editor/s, and the method proposed for recruiting papers, and the proposed time frame-for recruiting and processing the papers.

The Editor will consider publishing a research paper that is considerably longer than article length as a dedicated Special Issue of the *Journal of Organics*.
